

Innsbruck - Füssen - Innsbruck

Bookable as individual loop tour – 8 Days | 7 Nights, ca. 270 km

In a Nutshell | Distinctive Features

- Mostly paved cycle ways and country roads in the Inn and Lechtal valleys
- Shorter sections along less travelled side roads
- Some smaller uphill sections from Reutte to Garmisch (approx. 250 m height distance)
- Optional bus or train transfer from Garmisch to Innsbruck
- Suitable for children from 12 years of age (high amount of cycling enthusiasm required)

Arrival

Day 1: Individual Journey to Innsbruck

Visiting the alpine metropolis

Day 2: Innsbruck – Region Stams/Silz/Haiming (approx. 45 km)

Discover the fascinating Upper Inntal Valley; enjoy the view of Frgenstein castle ruins and visit the 1273 founded Stams Cistercian Monastery, the spiritual centre of the region. Water aficionados get their money's worth at today's stage destination: Haiming is **the** water and outdoor sports centre of Tyrol.

Day 3: Region Stams/Silz/Haiming – Steeg im Lechtal (approx. 50 km)

Passing the Roman Bath near Roppen the first part of the stage leads to Imst. To save energy a shuttle bus brings you across Hahntennjoch Pass and into the romantic mountain world of Lechtal Valley, where you ride to Steeg. The last white water river of the northern Alps will captivate you.

Day 4: Lech Valley Bike Tour from Steeg to Reutte (approx. 60 km)

You follow the course of the last white water river of Tyrol to the district capital of Reutte. Discover unknown worlds! Long gravel banks and lowland forests line the mountain river. On the wayside, some rare flora – lady's slipper and German tamarisk – can be found. The fauna is worth mentioning too: The common sandpiper and the little ringed plover nest in the gravel banks and the Bryodemella tuberculata's (a locust) chirping can be heard everywhere. Beware of the "Bluatschink", a Lechtal relation of the Scottish Loch Ness monster...

Day 5: In the Empire of the Swan King | Reutte – Füssen - Reutte (approx. 35 km)

Today you cross the federal border to Bavaria. In Füssen, you can visit the world-famous castles of Neuschwanstein and Hohenschwangau. His charming palaces made the melancholic King Ludwig II immortal. Maybe there is some time left to ride around Lake Forggensee.

Day 6: Zugspitze and Karwendel | Reutte – Garmisch - Innsbruck (approx. 45km)

After a hilly ride you get to the Olympic town of Garmisch-Partenkirchen. In Partenkirchen that is steeped in history you get an insight into traditional Lüftl façade painting. Then you take the bus or train back from Bavaria to Tyrol and can enjoy a ride along one of the most spectacular train routes of Europe. Like Emperor Maximilian, you cross the famous Martinswand rock face.

Day 7: Discover Innsbruck (approx. 25/35 km)

Discover the most beautiful sides of the Tyrolean provincial capital in the heart of the Alps – famous sights include the Arch of Triumph, Maria-Theresien-Straße, the Golden Roof, the new Nordkettenbahn cable railways, Schloss Ambras castle or the Bergisel ski jumping hill and are just as captivating as the hidden corners in the old part of town. Alternatively, you can join a guided mountain hike in the Innsbruck area (mid-June to late September).
