








Trans Austria



from INNSBRUCK to SALZBURG

Who thinks that the mountains of Tyrol and Salzburg are not possible to enjoy during a classical cycle tour in Austria, is wrong. You start your cycle vacations in Innsbruck and follow the cycle path of the Inntal valley downstream to Wörgl. From here you continue your bicycle tour in Tyrol primarily on level country roads with low traffic via Kufstein to St. Johann. Enjoy a train trip through the countryside of Salzburg and follow downstream the River Saalach to Salzburg. Also by the mountainous areas you can enjoy a nice cycle tour.

Highlights

-  Natural element water and wildly romantic meadows with unique wildlife

-  Culture and Mozart city Salzburg
-  Fortress Hohensalzburg, Palace Mirabell with Mirabell garden, Salzburg

Route characteristics

-  Gently hilly and paved/asphalted bike paths together with little-used secondary roads and local throughfares
-  Very good, officially marked and signposted cycle network

Itinerary

Day 1: Independent arrival in Innsbruck

Check in and you receive your travel documents for your cycle tour and rental bike handover, if booked. Take your time and enjoy a stroll through the beautiful old town of Innsbruck with its famous Goldenen Dachl.

Example of hotel: Hotel Austria Trend Hotel Congress**** in Innsbruck

Day 2: Innsbruck – Zillertal Valley (approx. 45 km)

Leaving the capital of the Tyrol behind and cycle through lovely picturesque villages and places until you reach Strass the access of the Zillertal Valley. Enjoy the breathtaking mountain scenery and take your time to explore the old town of Hall and in Wattens, the well-known world of the Swarovski-Crystals.

Example of hotel: Hotel Gasthof Post*** in Strass in the Zillertal Valley

Day 3: Zillertal Valley – Angerberg/Wörgl (approx. 25 km)

Numerous medieval fortresses and castles are along the cycle path until you cycle to the lovely village of Rattenberg. Visit the Tyrolean Museum of farmhouses in Kramsach, before you reach Wörgl.

Example of hotel: Gasthof Hotel Baumgarten*** in Wörgl

Day 4: Angerberg/Wörgl – Kirchberg/Kitzbühel (approx. 24 km)

You leave the Inntal Valley and cycle to the east in the ski-world of the Mt. Wilder Kaiser in the Brixental Valley. Your cycle trip in the Tyrol leads through picturesque villages to the world famous place of Kitzbühel.

Tip: the section Wörgl-Westendorf, can be shortened individually and comfortable by train (approx. 18 km/approx. 300 high altitude difference).

Example of hotel: Hotel Bechlwirt*** in Kirchberg/Tirol

Day 5: Kirchberg/Kitzbühel - Lofer (approx. 45 km)

Today cycle via the picturesque Lake Schwarzsee to St. Johann in Tirol. Enjoy a train ride from St. Johann to overcome the high altitude difference to Hochfilzen and via Leogang to Saalfelden in the Saalachtal Valley. From here, you continue your cycle holiday along the riverside of the River Saalach to Lofer in the Salzburger Land.

Example of hotel: Hotel Dax**** in Lofer

Day 6: Lofer - Salzburg (approx. 45 km)

Leaving Lofer behind and continue on the Tauern cycle path along the River Saalach via the so-called “green border” to the Bavarian Bad Reichenhall. Already after a few kilometres you cross the border once more before you reach Salzburg the birthplace of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart.

Example of hotel: Hotel Amedia Salzburg**** in Salzburg

Day 7: Individual departure or extra nights

Return journey by train to Innsbruck (included).
